IMPORTANT SAFETY REMINDERS

User manual - This cleaner should only be used for its intended purpose as described in these instructions. Ensure that these are fully understood before operating this appliance.

Only use attachments recommended or supplied by Hoover.

When using cleaning tools, ensure that the cleaner is kept in the upright (parked) position. This will avoid possible damage to the carpet or floor covering. When cleaning stairs, DO NOT position the cleaner above you.

STATIC ELECTRICITY. Some carpets can cause a small build up of static electricity. Any static discharge is not hazardous to health.

DO NOT use your cleaner out of doors or on any wet surface or for wet pick up.

Keep hands, feet, loose clothing and hair away from rotating brushes.

DO NOT pick up hard or sharp objects, matches, hot ashes, cigarette ends or other similar items.

DO NOT pick up flammable liquids such as cleaning fluids, petrol, etc or their vapours.

Aerosol sprays may be flammable. DO NOT spray near cleaner.

SUPPLY CORD. DO NOT run over the supply cord when using your cleaner or remove the plug by pulling on the supply cord.

FAULTS. DO NOT continue to use your cleaner if it appears to be faulty. If the supply cord is damaged stop using the cleaner IMMEDIATELY. The supply cord must be replaced by an authorised Hoover service engineer to avoid a safety hazard.

AFTER USE. Switch the cleaner off and remove the plug from the electricity supply. Always switch off and remove the plug before cleaning the appliance or attempting any maintenance task.

Safety with children, elderly or the infirm: Do not let children play with the appliance or its controls. Please supervise the use of the appliance by older children, the elderly or the infirm.

HOOVER SERVICE. To ensure the continued safe and efficient operation of this appliance we recommend that any servicing or repairs are only carried out by an authorised Hoover service engineer.

In the unlikely event that any item is missing or you experience any problems with the product, **DO NOT TAKE IT BACK TO THE SHOP**






PREPARING YOUR CLEANER









Screw handle in place with the screws provided.




Attach and screw hose hook in place.




Attach turbo nozzle to the cleaner.




Connect hose to the main ody of the cleaner.



Wrap hose around hose hook.



Attach the extension tube/crevice tool to cleaner.




Attach the dusting brush to the cleaner.

CARPET CARE CONTROL SELECTOR

The carpet care control selector raises and lowers the height of the foot.

For a medium pile carpet, the best carpet cleaning is achieved by setting the selector to the INTENSIVE CLEAN position.



For all other types of carpet try various settings until you get the best result for your carpet.

Ensure that the cleaner is in an upright (parked) position.

Rotate knob to position best suited to depth of carpet pile.


Note: Using this cleaner for loop carpets or carpets with pile greater than 30mm is not recommended. Please consult the floorcare/carpet manufacturer's recommended cleaning instruction before vacuuming.



IMPORTANT! When cleaning hard floors such as vinyl or linoleum, move the selector knob to the HARD floor position. Failure to do so may cause damage to the floor surface.


CLEANER RELEASE

Unlock the cleaner by pressing down on the pedal with your foot.



POWER SWITCH


To switch the cleaner on or off press down on the pedal with your foot.



CLEANER STORAGE

Turn the cleaner off and remove the plug. Wrap the cord around the cord storage hooks.

For quick release of the full length of the power cord, rotate the top storage hook.

CLEANING TOOLS*

Crevice Tool

For corners and hard to reach areas.

Dusting Brush

For bookshelves, frames, keyboards and other delicate areas.

Pet Hair & Allergen Remover*


The pet hair & allergen remover is ideal for removing pets hairs. DO NOT touch the rotating brush.

Hard Floor Caresse Nozzle*

The hard floor nozzle is ideal for cleaning delicate surfaces.


All accessories can fit onto the end of the flexible hose or end of the extension tube. Combine accessories depending on use.

Remove the hose from the foot. Remove the extension tube.




Slide the crevice tool out of the extension tube.









Fit the crevice tool or dusting brush to the extension tube or hose.



Fit the pet hair & allergen remover*Fit the hard floor caresse nozzle* to the crevice





IMPORTANT! When using cleaning tools, the cleaner must be kept in the upright position, particularly when cleaning stairs. The nozzle height should also be set to tool mode.

CLEANING THE STAIRS


It is dangerous to place the cleaner above you when cleaning stairs.

ALWAYS work with the cleaner below you. Ensure it is positioned up against the bottom step.



LONGER LENGTH HOSE HOOK*

For longer length hose*. Use the upper hose hook for storage.



EMPTYING THE DUST CONTAINER


To remove the dust container from the cleaner press the bin release button.



Hold the container over the bin and press the bin open button.

- The dust container door will open and you can empty with no contact with the dust.
- Once emptied, gently tap or shake the container to release any excess dust from the filters.

CLEANING THE PRE MOTOR FILTERS




1 Rotate the upper part of the dust bin to open.



Remove the filter assembly from the dust bin.




3 Separate the foam filter from the filter pack.




Wash both filters under hand warm water until the water runs clean. Remove excess water by shaking and leave to dry for 24 hours. When completely dry reassemble and refit filters to cleaner.

CLEANING THE EXHAUST FILTER



Remove the dust container rotate and remove the exhaust filter cover.



2 Remove the xhaust filter.



Wash the filter under hand warm water until the water runs clean. Remove excess water by shaking and leave to dry for 24 hours. When completely dry reassemble and refit filters to cleaner.

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CHANGING THE BELT OR BRUSHES

If your cleaner is not picking up efficiently, the belt or brushes (or both) may need replacing, but first please make sure you have:

- Emptied the dust container
- Cleaned the filters
- · Checked for blockages




IMPORTANT: Switch the cleaner off and remove the plug from the electricity supply before dismantling cleaner


Turn the cleaner over and remove 5 retaining screws attaching the brush guard to the




Hold the brush assembly and stretch the belt until the brush can be slotted back into the cleaner housing.









Remove the brush guard




Remove brush assembly and check for wear on the belt. Loop the new belt around the motor and brush channel.



Rotate the brush to ensure movement of the belt.



Refit the brush guard with 5 retaining screws.

CLEARING A BLOCKAGE




IMPORTANT: Switch the cleaner off and remove the plug from the electricity supply before dismantling cleaner

If cleaning tools were in use check the cleaning tool and the removable handle.



Check the hose by removing it from the cleaner, stretching it to full length.



Turn the cleaner over and rotate the brushes until they are free to rotate.



Check for a blockage in the hose socket. Use a flexible rod to remove any obstruction.



Open the nozzle at each side, lift cover and remove the blockage.

User checklist

If your cleaner is not working properly run through the following checklist.

- 1. Is there a working electricity supply to the cleaner? Check with another electrical product.
- 2. Is the dust container full or choked with fine dust?

 To empty the dust container, see instructions on P7.
- 3. Is the hose blocked?

 To clear a blockage, see instructions on P8.
- 4. Is there a blockage in the cleaner base?

 To clear a blockage, see the instruction on P8.
- 5. Are the filters blocked?

 To clean filters, see the instruction on P7.
- 6. Is the nozzle height set correctly?

 To set the carpet height selector, see the instruction on p4.
- 7. Are the brushes rotating correctly?

 To check the brushes, see the instructions on p8.
- 8. Has the cleaner overheated?

 If so, it will take about 30 minutes to reset.

If there is any doubt, call the Hoover customer Helpline 08444 995 599 for advice. They may be able to assist you over the telephone.

WARNING

A thermal cut out switches off the cleaner to prevent overheating if it is used when full or there is a blockage or dirty filters. If this should happen switch off, unplug and correct the fault.

It will take approximately 30 minutes for the cut out to automatically reset.

IMPORTANT

DO NOT RUN OVER THE POWER SUPPLY CORD AS THIS COULD DAMAGE THE SUPPLY CORD INSULATION.
